As of May 20th 2020, the Royal Government of Cambodia has mandated a 14-day quarantine for all travelers, both Cambodian and foreign nationals, arriving in Cambodia.

Upon arrival in the Kingdom of Cambodia, all travelers will be escorted to designated **Covid-19 centers for testing**, where they will be accommodated and must wait up to 24 hours for their results before being allowed to enter the country.

- If one traveler is tested positive, all travelers of the same flight will be subjected to a 14-day quarantine at a designated center by the Inter-Ministerial Committee to Combat Covid-19.
- If all results are negative, all travelers will be permitted to a 14-day self-isolation at their nominated accommodation under supervision of the local authorities and health officials. In addition, they are required to take a Covid-19 test on the 13th day of their self-isolation either at the Khmer-Soviet Friendship Hospital or at their designated provincial hospital.

The following travel restrictions remain in effect:

- Suspension of visa-free entry, tourist visas, e-visas and visas on arrival. Visas must be
 obtained from a Cambodian Embassy/Consulate abroad.
- All foreigners entering into Cambodia are required to possess a medical certificate certifying a negative COVID-19 status, issued by medical authority no more than 72 hours prior arrival in Cambodia.
- All foreigners must provide proof of their insurance policy with a minimum medical coverage of no less than US\$50,000 during their intended period of stay in Cambodia.
